

Minutes of the
St. Joseph's Society
February 13, 2008

All the bowls, napkins and utensils are provided. The meal will be in the cafeteria.

It was motioned that the Society fund two \$500.00 scholarships for Gillespie County Catholic Youth. The motion passed. Committee Reports – Steve Montgomery reported that the building committee is getting proposals on electric work in the Halle.
